Dear Friends and Neighbors,

On behalf of the Town of Greenville, I wanted to send an update to our entire community and address some of the widespread questions and feedback we have been receiving.

First and foremost, I want to take a moment to recognize our town's strength and resilience during unprecedented times. Recently, we have all experienced difficult days from the COVID-19 pandemic, either being personally affected or knowing someone who has been directly affected physically, financially or emotionally. Our town reported nearly 70 confirmed positive cases and we extend our deepest sympathies to the families who lost loved ones during the pandemic. It has been unsettling and tough to navigate our new normal but through all the uncertainty and hardships, we continue to persevere as a community and the amount of positivity to come through has been remarkable.

To our neighbors who are active first responders, health care professionals and essential workers, we thank you for the courage and guidance shown during this time, it's appreciated beyond words. To our entire Greenville community, the compassion and outpouring of support for one another has been truly special and something that we can continue to build upon over the next few months. Through the joint efforts of our residents, volunteers and local restaurants, Chianti Cow, Bottoms Up, Fire House Deli who teamed up with the Minisink Valley Kiwanis Club, Mountain View Fire Department, Johnson Fire Department, and The Michael and Erin Martucci Family Foundation; We were able to provide meals and extra assistance weekly to our senior members and local families needing a boost over the past couple months- a true collaborative partnership.

We are happy to report that our Town Municipal building and courts will be reopening for business as of June 1, 2020. Following our NYS guidelines, anyone entering the building will be required to wear a facial covering and follow the social distancing standards of 6 feet apart when possible. Our Senior center and learning center will remain closed with hopes of reopening in July, barring any additional state mandates. Please feel free to call ahead with any questions before coming in.

Our Town Park is open and any of the playground equipment and public facilities will be sanitized and cleaned frequently each day. The athletic fields and trails are open for individual/personal use but not sanctioned for public or organized team gatherings at this time.

Unfortunately, our annual spring clean-up days in April were postponed due to budget cuts from the impact of COVID-19. We are looking to possibly reschedule later in the fall.


A special thanks to our Town Highway Supervisor, Jim Ferguson and highway department who continue to work hard maintaining and updating our roads and public grounds. The extra effort in improving the park, athletic fields and cleaning up storm debris has been outstanding. With the support from our new Town Board, our team is continuing to execute pre-planned projects for the 2020 year, including a revamped town building as well as following through with the removal of unsafe structures and enforcing compliance code around town. We are in the process of assembling a new committee with help from an outside group who will prepare an updated comprehensive plan to ensure and prioritize Greenville's community planning over the next few months.

As the state continues to open up in various phases, we will continue to evaluate our progress and implement any restrictions as we may find necessary. We know and understand we have a long road ahead and are all in this together. We have found it's the little things that go a long way, so if we all continue to do our part, follow health guidelines and continue to show acts of kindness we will pull through together.

When I started in the Town Supervisor position this past January, never did we foresee something of this magnitude that could debilitate our nation from east to west, from big cities to small towns, from corporations to our small businesses from our elderly to our grade school students...everyone has been affected in some way. As I said when I started in this role, my commitment and love for our Town of Greenville and the people who live here is unwavering. We will continue to work together to get through each day and figure out ways we can improve and continue to prosper even on the tough days.
